

Always buy from the Authorized Manufacturer/ Dealer

There are various brands out there with brilliant product quality, and if the users are very particular about their accessories, then they should stick with the brand and buy these accessories from their authorized dealers to avoid counterfeit products. In case a battery needs to be replaced, always follow the instructions which requires the users to play safe and sound.



Always check how battery looks like

It is quite perturbing when the fake batteries look identical to the original ones. Before buying a battery, inspect it further and look for clues or uncanny marks that might make you suspect or question the originality. Look for misspelled labels, inaccurate printing, logos which doesn't add up et al. Looking for one these might help the you judge the authenticity of the battery.



Always check for the Warranty

This is perhaps the most important question of all times since warranty, and any post-sale services are not being provided unless the batteries are original. The warranty period can vary from few months to a year where the manufacturers provide repair/replacement if anything happens to the product with quality customer care services.



Always check the Prices

Counterfeit batteries are made out of refurbished materials or cheap components which have no guarantee of serving the device since they can die on the customer at anytime. That cuts down the production cost since it also doesn't involve a product R & D team nor has any post-production quality tests. Naturally, the prices are 1/3 of its original ones that make them alluring for some people, but most of these people suffer the consequences of a bad product.



People make mistakes, and in cases of getting hold of a fake battery, it is strongly advised that they return it to the seller or report them directly to the authorities. A refund should also be issued by the seller, and a proper report should be filed, and the OG seller must also be notified with products like these. Likewise, it should be a reflex for the customers to ask all the relevant questions to determine the authenticity of these products.

These all are advice one should take to find fake vs real battery.
